Today's Open House Public Involvement Workshop is set-up to facilitate your review of the alternatives currently being studied for future transportation improvements in Northwest Butler County. This workshop is your opportunity to learn more about those alternatives under consideration (including those highlighted by the Advisory Committee) and to provide your thoughts on the alternatives.

The work of the Northwest Butler Transportation Study is illustrated at this workshop through displays arranged in five stations:

- Station 1: Background and Problem Identification,
- Station 2: Study Process and the Role of Public Involvement,
- Station 3: Development of Alternatives,
- Station 4: Evaluation of Alternatives, and
- Station 5: Comment Area.

The stations are arranged clockwise along the perimeter of the room and are best viewed in sequence beginning with Station 1. Feel free to explore the exhibits at your own pace. Project Study Team and Advisory Committee members (wearing name tags) are on hand to answer your questions about the study and to help you interpret the displays. There will be a short, slide presentation given at 4:45 and 5:45 PM in the adjacent room.

Please be sure to visit the comment area in Station 5, **one of the most important** stations at this workshop, to let us know your thoughts, particularly on the alternative solutions under consideration.

Your input is vital to creating a successful long range transportation plan for Northwest Butler County.
