Day 0 - 5



Stay at home/isolate.

Day 0 is the day you test positive for COVID.

Day 6

- Check your temperature.If you are fever free for 24 hrs, return to work and wear a mask in public areas and around others.
- If you still have a fever, continue to isolate until 24 hrs fever free.

Day 7-10

Practice social distancing and wear a mask.

Stay away from others as much as possible and mask when in public areas and around others.

Day 0 - 10

Watch for symptoms.

If you have had close contact with someone who has tested positive for COVID, monitor symptoms closely for the next 10 days.

The Butler County Health Department encourages masking if you know you had close contact. BCEO does not require you to wear a mask with no symptoms.

Use common sense!



At the onset of symptoms after close contact with someone who has tested positive for COVID, tell your supervisor and leave the premises. Take a COVID test and follow the guidelines on the left side of this page.

If you consider yourself to be high risk, the BCEO encourages you to take the precautions you deem necessary to protect yourself.
